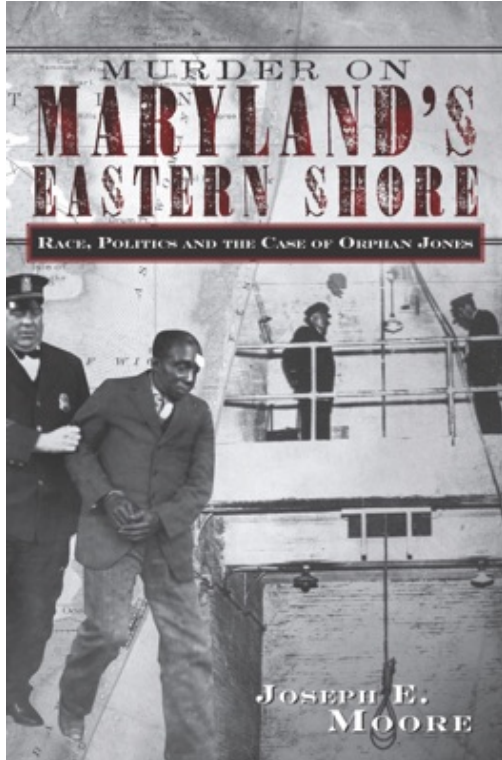


Download Murder on Maryland's Eastern Shore free Joseph E. Moore (PDF, ePub, Mobi)

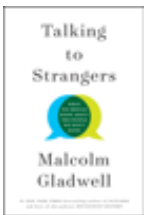

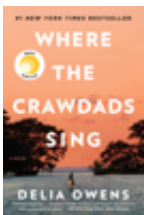
